Series Regulations



1. General.

All events in the 2010 Albins Off Road Gear "Donlakerie" Tri-Series will be a state series conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS), Off Road Standing Regulations, these Series Regulations and the Supplementary Regulations as published by the Organisers of each event as well as any Further Regulations or Instructions which may be issued.

All events will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS risk management and occupational, health and safety policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

2. Advertising.

By entering any event in the 2010 Albins Off Road Gear "Donlakerie" Tri Series, Clubs, Corporations and persons agree to refer to the series by its full title: - 2010 Albins Off Road Gear "Donlakerie" Tri-Series. All promotional material must include the full title. CAMS Ltd. is to be recognised on all event paperwork.

3. Events.

a. General

The three events will be long course off road events as defined in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

b. Starting Order

Starting Order will be as specified by the individual event Supplementary Regulations and may be determined by the running of a prologue or seeding.

c. Finisher

To be classified as a finisher a crew must complete either the complete course or the specified number of laps within the time duration allowed by the organisers, as specified in the Supplementary Regulations / Further Regulations for the event.

d. Points

Points will be awarded as per the Point Score below.

The first six competitors in every class will receive points in order of finish, i.e.

1st - 6 points

2nd - 5 points

3rd - 4 points

4th - 3 points

5th - 2 points

6th - 1 point

1. Each competitor will receive 2-points for starting each event
2. There must be a minimum of 5 cars in each class starting the event to receive the above points
3. If four or less cars start the event in any class then points will be as follows for that particular class
 - 1st – 4 points
 - 2nd – 3 points
 - 3rd – 2 points
 - 4th – 1 point

The competitor with the highest points will be the winner and the prizes will be presented after the end of the third and final round of the Albins Off Road Gear "Donlakerie" Tri-Series.

- \$1500 to the winner
- \$600 to the 2nd place getter
- \$400 to the 3rd place getter.

If a dispute occurs in relation to these series regulations, representatives of each of the three clubs will adjudicate. If the matter can not be resolved, the matter may be referred to the CAMS judicial system – refer to the National Competition Rules of CAMS relating to Protests and Appeals.

4. Competitor Eligibility.

Each driver, co-driver and navigator must hold a current and valid CAMS National Off Road Licence, ie: NO, NON, NOJ, NONJ, NONSE and be a current financial member of a CAMS affiliated club.

5. Vehicle Eligibility.

With reference to the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, vehicles must comply with the requirements of the National Competition Rules, and Off Road Standing Regulations as per Article 4.2 (i).

6. Series Schedule

The 2010 Albins Off Road Gear "Donlakerie" Tri-Series will consist of the following rounds:

2nd – 4th April – The Donald 400

11th – 13th June - The Sea Lake Mallee Rally
