The 2018 Mellool Short Course will be conducted, by the Sea Lake Off Road Club Inc, at Danbury Park, Mellool in the state of New South Wales on Saturday, 7th April, 2018.

The event is held under the National Competition Rules of Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd, (AASA) the AASA General Requirements Off Road Racing, AASA Technical Regulations Off Road Racing and Series Regulations of the 2018 Victorian Off Road Club Shield regulations, these event regulations and any further regulations and bulletins issued. ENTRY DETAILS

Entries open on the 25th March, 2018 and close at 9am, Saturday 7th April, 2018.

The fee for entries received by 11.59pm on Wednesday, 4th April will be \$150.00 For entries received after the 4th April the entry fee will be \$200.

Additional navigators may compete, providing they are properly nominated on the entry form and an additional fee of \$20.00 is paid.

Entries are limited to 60 and acceptance will be determined in order of receipt. Entries can only be submitted via the official Entry Form and must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee. Entries can be submitted by either mail or email to the official addresses listed above.

Entries withdrawn by advice ONLY TO THE EVENT SECRETARY before 5pm Friday, 6th April, will receive a full refund.

Please quote your RACE VEHICLE NUMBER and DRIVERS SURNAME as reference number when paying by Direct Debit, so that payments can be accounted for. Account details are on the Official Entry Form.

The organisers reserve the right to abandon, cancel or postpone the event if less than 20 entries received by the close of entries or affected by adverse weather.

SCHEDULE

Saturday, 7 th April, 2018	
8am – 9.30am	Scrutineering at the track. Please ensure you present your competition licence, Logbook/passport and membership cards at documentation.
9.45am	Crew Briefing
10am	Reconnaissance. <i>All competition crew will be given the opportunity to reconnoitre the course proper <u>once only</u> in their race vehicle in a race ready condition. Helmets, gloves, etc.</i>
11am	Start of 2018 Mellool Short Course

Event Notes:

1. Competitors will be required to complete 10 laps of the course (15kms each lap). It will consist of three sections comprising of 1 lap, regroup the field, 4 continuous laps in the second section and 5 continuous laps in the third section. A reconnaissance lap will be held prior to the event. Competitors will be seeded for the start of the event.
2. **Refuelling**
Refuelling is to be carried out in accordance with the regulations. ie. Car switched off before removal of fuel cap, crew to wearing long sleeves and pants, etc. Crew member to be holding fire extinguisher
3. **Allowed Time**
To be classified as a finisher, a crew shall complete all sections.
4. **PENALTIES**
 - (a) Short cutting – 1st breach = Clerk of the Course discretion, 2nd breach = exclusion
 - (b) Causing damage to property deemed by the Clerk of the Course to have been deliberate = Exclusion
 - (c) Refuelling whilst the engine is not switched off &/or any person is inside the vehicle = Exclusion
 - (d) Failure to obey flags, first breach = 30 minutes, second breach = Exclusion.
5. **PIT/PADDOCK AREA & PASSES**

Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are not permitted in the pit/paddock, designated refuel area or welding area
Welding may only occur in the area designated for this purpose.
Anyone under the age of 14 must be under adult supervision at all times whilst in the paddock area.
Breaches of these regulations may be referred to the Clerk of Course which may result in a penalty.
5. **Recovery**
Official recovery vehicles, identified by a white flag, will attend to all disabled vehicles throughout the event. Disabled competition vehicles will be towed back to the pit/paddock area. Competition vehicles that are unable to be towed will be moved to a safe position and may not be recoverable until the completion of the event.
6. **Timing and Start Lights/Flags**
Timing for the event will be to the elapsed second and will be expressed in hours, minutes and seconds. A competitor's score will be his/her elapsed total time for all sections. The Chief Timekeeper is deemed Judge of Fact of any timing discretions during event.

To qualify as a finisher of the event, competitors must complete all laps of the course within the specified late time limit. All competitors will be advised of late running time at crew briefing.
7. **Trophies** - Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes as combined and 1st, 2nd and 3rd outright, as per below.

Unlimited

Class 1 / Class 10

Class 2 / Class 3

Class 6 / Class 66

Class 4 / Class 5

Class 7 / Class 8
8. **Miscellaneous**

Speed in non-competition areas is 20km/h.
No persons other than officials, accredited media or competing crew shall be permitted on the course.
We request that there be NO DOGS as we are using private property.
If you break down and are not continuing the event, please report to the event secretary.
Catering will be provided at the track
Presentation of trophies will be held ASAP at the track at the conclusion of the event.
There will be a designated car park, spectator area and pit/paddock area.
All drivers, co-drivers, navigators and pit crews must sign the entry form.
A logbook/passport, current competition licence and current club membership must be produced.
