ARB AUSTRALIAN OFF ROAD RACING CHAMPIONSHIP

REGULATIONS











1. GENERAL

All events in the 2018 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship will be conducted in accordance with these ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Regulations, the Event Regulations, any Additional Regulations and/or Announcements/Bulletins as published by the Organisers.

All events will be conducted with consideration to risk management and occupational, health and safety.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

The 2018 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship will consist of the following rounds:

Round 1	Griffith, NSW	16-18 March
Round 2	Mildura, Vic	20-22 April
Round 3	Sea Lake, Vic	08-10 June
Round 4	Waikerie, SA	13-15 July
Round 5	Goondiwindi, Qld	17-19 August
Round 6	Millicent, SA	22-23 September

3. ADVERTISING

By entering any event in the 2018 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship, Clubs, Corporations and persons agree to refer to the Championship by its full title: - ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship. All promotional material must include the full title. To be eligible for points, competitors shall display supplied decals on each side of vehicle.

4. EVENTS

General

Events will be long course off road events.

Starting Order

Running a Prologue will be the preferred method of determining the event starting order and may include a shootout. If a prologue is not able to be run, the event starting order will be determined by recent prologue results.

A crew/driver not finishing the prologue may, on application to the Clerk of the Course, be seeded into the starting order based on recent prologue results.

Finisher

To be classified as a finisher a crew must complete 100% of the complete course within the time duration allowed by the organisers, as specified in the Event Regulations, Additional Regulations or as announced at the event competitor briefing.

5. FORWARD FACING NUMBERS ON VEHICLES

Forward facing numbers shall be fixed to the top right hand corner of the vehicle's sun visor and be 75mm in height or located on bonnet and 'must be visible for officials when lining up cars'.

6. POINTS

Points will be awarded as per the following Point Score. Competitors must have registered with the Championship online at arboffroadracing.com.au prior to close of event entry to receive points for that and any subsequent events in the Championship.

Only the driver is eligible for points. Competitors are only eligible for points with one entry per event. A driver can nominate a navigator to receive end of Championship awards.

A competitor's best score from any four of the six rounds will be used to calculate the point score for 2018.

CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION POINTS

20 outright and class points will be awarded to each competitor who registers for the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship prior to the close of entries for round 1 of the Championship. Championship registration points will only apply to competitors who enter and start an event.

START AND FINISH POINTS

Start points

5 outright points and 5 class points will be awarded to each valid entry prepared to start the event. (ie entered crew and vehicle presented for scrutiny at the event scrutiny venue).

Finish points

10 outright points and 10 class points will be awarded to each Championship registered competitor who has completed 100% of the entered event.

OUTRIGHT AND CLASS POINTS

Outright and class points will be awarded based on laps completed and total elapsed time to each competitor who completes 75% or more of the event relative to all other Championship registered competitors according to the tables below, provided they meet all other requirements.

7. TITLES AND AWARDS

ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship outright winner - Driver

As well as receiving trophies, the first 3 place getters in outright position will receive prizes as determined by the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Committee.

ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship winner – Driver

As well as receiving trophies, the first 3 place getters in each class will receive prizes as determined by the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship Committee.

Titles and Awards Presentation

The ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship awards will be provisionally presented at the presentation dinner of the event for the final round of the ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship.

To be eligible for Championship awards the competitor must *have entered and* started at least 3 ARB Australian Off Road Racing Championship events and be classified as a finisher in at least one event.

TIES/COUNTBACK

Outright

In the event of a tie within the top three placings outright, the winner will be determined by a countback - whomever had the higher outright finishing positions.

Class

In the event of a tie within the top three placings of a class, the winner will be determined by a countback - whomever had the higher class finishing positions. If the competitors earned the same finishing positions the winner will be decided on who placed higher in the outright Championship points. In the event of a tie for the outright position, the winner will be decided on whomever had the higher outright finishing positions throughout the year.

COMPETITION NUMBERS

First, second and third outright place getters will be eligible to run competition numbers 1, 2 and 3 for the following year at AORRA sanctioned events.

First, second and third class place getters will be eligible to run competition numbers 01, 02, and 03 in their class, ie 101, 102, 103, 401, 402, 403 etc for the following year at AORRA sanctioned events.
