After a 12 month hiatus due to COVID, the Griffith Club have been busy moving to a brand new venue at Hillston - 60km north of the previous location at Stackpoole where a quality field is expected for the 2021 edition!

This year's event will see prologue and one 83km lap completed on the Saturday, with four laps scheduled for the Sunday, and with a fresh new track, Hillston is certain to throw some surprises.
